Pitting

Indoor pitting is available on a first come first serve basis. Pits for bikes and 4 wheelers will get priority over karts in the racing arena to keep tires dry. This will also be on a first come first serve basis. The main pit area will be in a building just 150 ft from the race track. All buildings are heated! Each entry will get ONE 10x10 pit stall. Extra stalls will be \$20 per stall.

If the indoor pits become full the remaining competitors will pit outside.
